The back is engraved "USA AL SHELTON STUDIO CITY, CA IN 'WHO'S WHO IN THE WEST'" on one end and "THE STUNTMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF MOTION PICTURES AND TELEVISION WAS FOUNDED IN HOLLYWOOD CALIF. 1961 BY PROFESSIONAL STUNTMENT" in the center. On the hook is the Stuntman's Association logo in a circle. The back has a wooden plank design with a star and leaf scrolls on the side with the maker's mark.
