A bookend set of a cast ceramic coat of arms. The bookends are numbered 1 out of a limited edition of 1000 created for the Royal wedding of the Duke and Duchess of York. The book ends with a depiction of a lion, each holding a different coat of arms. The coat of arms on the right depicts a plant growing out of a mound between two leaves and three thistle stalks with purple blossoms all conjoined in the base. In the middle blossom is a honeybee. The coat of arms on the left depicts the coat of arms of Edward VIII and Charles III as Prince of Wales, with a white label of three points and the center point bearing a blue anchor.
