**Historical Note**

The Panda family--mother, father, and baby--were a gift from the Gift of the Students of Shanghai Children's Palace following Mrs. Reagan's visit in April of 1984. Visiting with over 700 children, Mrs. Reagan watched a performance by the center's Little Ambassadors, a group of 27 musicians and dancers, as well as a puppet show. The Shanghai Children's Palace, originally built by Song Qingling in 1953, is a place where children from the ages of 5-14 can study calligraphy, dancing, and the arts.
