

**Historical Note**

Rube Marquard was a left-handed pitcher in Major League Baseball from 1908-1925, where he played for the New York Giants, Brooklyn Robins, Cincinnati Reds, and Boston Braves. In 1908, the New York Giants paid him a record \$11,000, and he was initially known as "the \$11,000 lemon." However, he led the team to three consecutive National League pennants (1911-13), winning at least 23 games each season. He was elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1971.
