A bronze sculpture of a Spanish gaucho on horseback spearing a wild boar on a wood base. The sculpture is numbered 7 out of 15 and is signed "A Coello."

Historical Note

The sculpture, by artist Antonio Coello de Portugal, is number 7/15. The King and Queen of Spain were supposed to visit on December 9, 1983, but were prevented from visiting. The piece had already been delivered in advance of the meeting, and during the Reagan administration it was on display in the White House West Wing Study.
