Historical Note
18kt gold Claddagh ring. Inside it's engraved "President Reagan Galway 1984." It was given during a trip to Ireland June 1-4, 1984. A Claddagh features two hands clasping a heart topped with a crown. It represents love, loyalty, and friendship. It has different meanings depending on which way it is worn and whether it faces the wearer or viewer. It often has been used as a wedding ring.
