Inc WILLIAMS OREGON, A hundred years ago, Klamath County began to settle into cattle agriculture and timber industries. Roads and trade systems of the economic sections were built on many of the Indian trails developed for intertribal trade. In many cases towns developed at the sites of original tribal villages. The Klamath Indian culture began to feel the changes in adapting to a reservation system.
