**Description**

A desk clock in a small wooden box. The clock is a "NAVIQUARTZ III,' MODEL NO. 1215 HF; Naviquartz Chronometer" Patek Philippe, Genève, mahogany quartz chronometer with center-seconds, stop feature, and

battery power-reserve indicator. Three-tier, hinged corners, and sides are reinforced by brass inlays in the tradition of deck watches, with the bottom being a folding brass stand. White with bold radial Roman numerals, outer minute track, below on the dial plate two apertures, right for push-button activating power-reserve indication, left for the indicator. Black "Breguet" hands. With quartz standardization, an electronic hack mechanism for stopping for precision setting. On the inside of the lid is a small metal engraved plaque.
